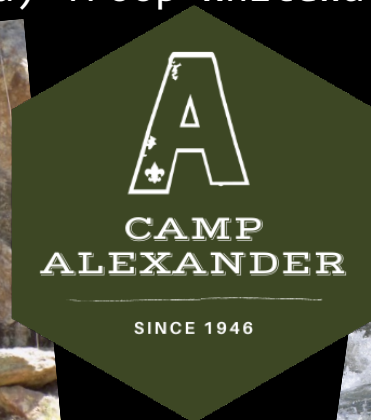

- **By December 1, 2023 - \$50 payment (Total of \$100 paid)**

- **By April 1, 2023 - \$170 payment (Total of \$470 paid) + \$90 if Whitewater Rafting**
- **By June 1, 2023 - \$100 payment (Total of \$570 paid) [Estimated Travel Fees]**

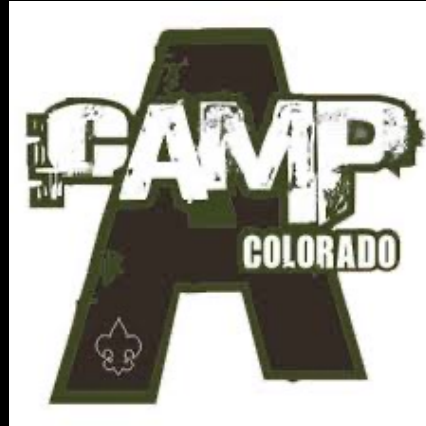
