Troop 360 Uniform Code

Throughout your Scouting career, you will be required to wear an official Scouting uniform. Outlined below are specific requirements for Troop 360.

Board of Review Dress Code:

1. Scouts going before the Board of review will wear the approved BSA "Class A" Shirt.

What MUST be on the BSA Shirt (Class A):

- Any Council patch (Alamo Area Council)
- Troop Number patch (360)
- Current rank
- Patrol patch

- Leadership patch
- Epaulettes
- World Scouting Patch
- ** Correct positioning of patches can be referenced in the BSA Scouting handbook to ensure proper display.
- 2. Scouts must wear official Scout pants, nice blue jeans, or khaki pants with no holes or tears. Scouts may also wear Scout shorts or any khaki shorts. Sweat pants and sport shorts are not allowed.
 - a. If shorts are worn (BSA or khaki), the Scout MUST wear official Scout socks.
- 3. Scouts must wear a "Classic" Scout belt from any Scout Camp (BSA, Philmont, Bear Creek, El Rancho Cima, etc.) or a BSA belt regardless of what style pants are worn.
- 4. Scouts will wear an official BSA neckerchief and a neckerchief slide (i.e. Troop 360 Neckerchief, OA Neckerchief, National Jamboree Neckerchief).
- 5. Scout will wear the merit badge sash, over the right shoulder. A Scout wearing the long sleeved Class A shirt is authorized to wear up to 6 merit badges on his right lower sleeve, displayed in accordance with the BSA handbook. If a Scout has not yet earned any merit badges, the sash is optional.
- 6. An official BSA Scout hat or a hat from a prior Scout camp or training session is optional, but must be serviceable and in good condition.

Troop Meeting Dress Code:

Labor Day through NEISD Summer Break-

- Class A Shirt (complete to include all current patches)
- Pants/Shorts (as described above)

NEISD Summer Break through Labor Day-

- Class B Shirt (any Scout related T-Shirt)
 - o Troop 360 shirts may be purchased.
- Pants/Shorts (as described above)

Troop Travel Dress Code:

- Class A Shirt (complete to include all current patches)
- Pants/Shorts (as described above)

Approved Footwear:

A pair of closed toed shoes must always be worn (tennis shoes or hiking boots are preferred). No sandals, flip-flops or Crocs.
